The Last Favourite

"The Last Favourite" tells the bizarre story of an old man, whose daughter wants to incapacitate him. He tells his life story to his appraiser. How growing up in the 50s, he begins to search for pictures of naked women during his puberty and only finds nude paintings in the art volumes of his parents. Thereafter, it's the catalogue pages of ladies' underwear, then pictures of starlets in magazines, and finally the half-naked playmates in male adult magazines. And in the late 60s it's porn actresses, who satisfy the then mathematics student. He gets into a fight with his professor, because he used a computer to assist him in solving a problem. Instead of pursuing his doctorate, he starts a software company, and thus makes millions. At the end of his life, he realizes his dream through the assistance of virtual reality and artificial intelligence. And he meets the woman, whom his daughter tries to eliminate from his life.


